Girls Rock Camp Vancouver is a non-profit society that builds self-esteem in female and non-binary youth through music creation and performance. By providing workshops and technical training, we create leadership opportunities, cultivate a supportive community of peers and mentors, and encourage social change and the development of life skills.

2017 Camp Dates: July 10th to 14th (9am-4:30pm), and July 15th (Early Show)

CAMPER REQUIREMENTS:

Campers must be between the ages of 8 and 17 at the time of camp. No exceptions.

Campers need not have any musical experience!

Attendance at the showcase is integral to the experience of camp; please plan to attend.

First-come, first-served space permitting. **12 positions are reserved for** Native youth (Indigenous, Metis, Inuit, First Nations, Status, Non-Status).

Tuition: Sliding Scale \$0 - \$300 (basic amount). Please contact us regarding our monthly giving plan if you're able to pay more at info@girlsrockcampvancouver.ca. Tuition covers lunches and snacks for all campers, and one ticket to the Showcase (Campers are on the guestlist).

Camp this year will again be hosted at, and kindly donated by, Urban Native Youth Association, 1618 Hastings at Commercial. The showcase venue is The Rio Theatre, 1660 East Broadway at Commercial. Both venues are accessible by public transit and bike parking is available.

** We **STRONGLY** suggest that you submit your application as soon as possible. We will post space availability on our website and you will be notified of application status via email. ** Don't worry about sending tuition in with your application, we'll let you know if you or your camper has a spot, and when and how to pay. Youth who hear about camp through UNYA are welcome to leave applications there, but otherwise we only accept applications via mail (not courier) to the address below.
